The Macnas Parade will twist and turn through streets broad and narrow. Every spot along the route has a great view. Please follow the directions of stewards and if you feel crowded somewhere, just follow the route to find your ideal spot. Below are our top tips to help you decide the best spot for you!



Route info

This year the Macnas parade will travel along one route only, so you'll see the full spectacle from wherever you stand along its journey. The parade travels through broad and narrow streets so you can get close to the performers and the structures as they pass you by.

Moore St → Henry St → Mary Street → Capel St → Little Britain St → Halston St → Mary's Lane



About the Parade

FAMILIES

Arrive early - there will be big crowds and you'll want to settle into the right spot before it starts. We suggest Henry Street, Mary Street and Capel Street for families so you can have the widest view of the parade.

UP CLOSE AND PERSONAL

Want an up-close view of the performers and the mechanics of the floats? The smaller streets from Little Britain Street to where the route ends at Mary's Lane are for you.

OLDER AUDIENCES

Want a bit more breathing space? We'd suggest Little Britain Street - it's wide, with fewer crowds than the main shopping streets.

ACCESSIBILITY

While the whole route is wheelchair accessible, there are two designated viewing areas for people with disabilities. Space is limited in these areas and needs to be reserved. Please email **info@bramstokerfestival.com** for further information.

As a general rule for all, we would suggest avoiding junctions & corners, as these bottlenecks tend to be the spots with poorest visibility.
